Beulah Burman's PET Projects is committed to finding the most suitable homes for our adoptable pets. In accepting this animal you must agree to be bound by the following rules and conditions:

- I understand that PET Projects reserves the right to refuse adoptions.
- I understand that PET Projects cannot guarantee the health, temperament, or training of the animal and will not be responsible for the nature and condition of the adopted animal, or for any medical expense after the animal leaves our shelter/care.
- I agree to provide a good home and humane treatment for the adopted animal. Specifically this includes adequate shelter, nourishment, and veterinary care.
- I understand that this animal is not to be used for any research, experimental, or breeding purposes.
- I realize that no animal will be adopted out for any purpose other than as a household pet.
- I assume all risks of injury to or loss of my pet.
- I understand that I may not adopt a pet for anyone other than immediate family, and that PET Projects will not release any animal to persons under 18 years of age unless a guardian co-signs this form.
- If this animal has not been sterilized, I agree to have the animal spayed (female) or neutered (male) when the animal comes of age. If I fail to have the animal spayed or neutered, this failure shall be treated as a fundamental breach of this agreement. PET Projects may as its' sole option repudiate the agreement and repossess the animal.
- I agree to license, control, and treat the animal according to all laws and bylaws.
- All pets require training and housebreaking to prevent behavioural problems and they also require adjustments to family and/or other pets. I accept full responsibility for this training.
- An adopted animal usually requires an adjustment period of at least two weeks in a new home. I agree to allow adequate adjustment time, however I understand that in legitimate circumstances the animal can be returned to PET Projects.
- PET Projects shall have the right to inspect the animal from time to time, and if the conditions under which it is kept are not satisfactory, the animal may be repossessed.
